

TERMS AND CONDITIONS
Sing for the Sixers Competition

1. **iiNet Limited** (ABN 48 068 628 937) of 502 Hay Street, Subiaco WA 6008 ("we" or "us") are responsible for conducting the '**Sing for the Sixers' Competition**' ("the Competition").
2. By entering into this Competition you agree to these Terms and Conditions.

Competition Period

4. The Competition commences at 9:00am (/AEST) on December 8th 2014 and closes at 12 midnight (/AEST) on January 14th 2015.
5. Entries must be received by us during this period.

Conditions of Entry

6. Entry is open to Australian residents in NSW, QLD, VIC, SA, ACT, WA, NT aged 5 years or over at the date of entry.
7. To enter the Competition you must submit one line for the second verse of the Sixers anthem ("Entry").
8. You may only enter the Competition once a week. We reserve the right to check the validity of all Entries and to disqualify you if we reasonably believe that your Entry does not comply with these Terms and Conditions or the entry process has been tampered with.

Competition Draw

9. The Competition is a game of skill. Chance pays no part in determining the winners.
10. To submit an Entry you must enter one line for the second verse of the Sixers anthem at www.sixershistory.com.au. Each week Entries will be reviewed and a weekly winner will be announced online at www.sixershistory.com.au.
11. Each Entry will be judged according to its originality and creativity. The best Entry each week as judged by us will be deemed the 'Weekly Winner'. There will be a total of four Weekly Winners, (with one winning Entry selected each week over four consecutive weeks).
12. Each week there will also be 10 consolation prizes given away. These will be for the 10 next best Entries that week, as judged by us.
13. Judging will take place at 1pm (AEST) on Monday 15th and Tuesday 23rd December 2014 and Wednesday 7th and Thursday 15th January 2015 at iiNet, Level 4, 233 Castlereagh St, Sydney NSW 2000.
14. If we are unable to contact a Weekly Winner by 4pm (AEST) on Monday 15th and Tuesday 23rd December 2014 and Wednesday 7th and Thursday 15th January 2015, that winner will forfeit the 'Weekly Winner' Prize and become a consolation prize winner. We will then contact the other consolation prize winners in the order in which their Entry has been ranked by our judges. The first consolation prize winner to answer their phone will be deemed the Weekly Winner.
